






2. What discipline do you represent? (n=153)







3. What is your gender? (n=153)




Occupation by gender (percent)












6. Roughly what percentage of your breast cancer patients have some problems with hot flushes




7. Roughly what percentage of your breast cancer patients have severe hot flushes that affect daily living and quality of sleep




8. If you treat hot flushes medically what do you use?




